NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Commissioners of Bingham County will, on or before the hour of 9:00 a.m. on the 11th day of December 2024, receive sealed proposals for bids at the office of the County Clerk in the Courthouse, 501 N. Maple Street #204, Blackfoot, ID, to be opened at a meeting by the County Commissioners to be held at 9:00 a.m. on the 11th day of December 2024 for the following:

Furnishing of Asphalt for 2025 Oiling Season

Copies of bid documents may be obtained from the Clerk's Office in the Courthouse at 501 N. Maple Street, Blackfoot, Idaho.

The County Commissioners reserve the right to reject all bids, non-responsive bids, bids of nonresponsible bidders, or to accept in whole or part such a bid or bids as may be deemed in the best interest of the County. The County retains the right to have a sixty – (60) day award period after the bid opening in order to evaluate other public entity bids.

Individuals who need accessible communication or other accommodations in order to participate in this bid are invited to make their needs and preferences known to the ADA/504 Compliance Coordinator, Laraine Pope, Bingham County Human Resource, at least 3 to 5 days in advance of the bid opening.

Bidders shall submit their bids to on the county form supplied by Bingham County. No Bid Bond is required for the bid opening.

**BINGHAM COUNTY
SPECIFICATIONS FOR ASPHALT**

Asphalts supplied to Bingham County under this contract shall conform to the applicable parts of the latest edition of the "Standard Specifications for Highway Construction" of the State of Idaho Transportation Department, and to the latest ASTM standards for the specific materials being delivered.

The bid is broken into sections. It is further understood that the freight price will be adjusted for each agency piggy-backing off this bid. If there are additional or hidden costs, they must be disclosed at this time. The County has the option of accepting and awarding individual products, or segregating the bid by purchasing the oil, or transportation based upon the line item total, from a bidder for each company.

The lowest product price may not be the lowest cost to the county; the decision will be made by using the lowest overall cost.

All asphalt materials must meet current Idaho Transportation Department Standard Specifications. The County may at its discretion, randomly sample any or all loads, to determine specification compliance. A penalty of twenty-five (25) percent of the total purchase price will be deducted from each load not meeting specifications.

The undersigned has carefully examined the specifications and contract documents and also understands that all materials and services called for shall be for the price bid.

The undersigned has also carefully checked all of the figures, and understands that Bingham County or any officer thereof will not be responsible for any errors or omissions on the part of the undersigned submitting this bid.

Technical support is expected as part of this Bid Document. Technical support shall include the supplier providing on site or telephone support to advise the County in oil and aggregate application methods or rates. Normally, the Technical Support requires less than 80 hours per season.

The Bidder recognizes and agrees that this bid is available to other government agencies in accordance with Idaho Code. Counties, Cities, and Highway Districts may only piggy-back on this bid for 60 days from the date of the bid opening because of the changing nature of oil prices.

The Bidder will bill the different entities directly for any of the liquid asphalt and transportation ordered independently.

The successful bidder or bidders shall furnish a \$1,000,000 Liability Insurance Certificate to the County, naming Bingham County as an additional insured.
