DISCLOSURE: The purposes for which this
supplemental maintenance and operations
levy will be used include:

Technology, Devices, and Software	\$65,000

QUESTION: "Shall the Board of Trustees of
Aberdeen School District No. 58, Bingham
County, State of Idaho, be authorized to
levy a supplemental levy, as permitted by
law in Section 33-802(3), Idaho Code, in the
amount of Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand
and no/100 dollars (\$950,000) per year for
a period of two (2) years, commencing with
the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026 and
ending June 30, 2028, for the purpose of
paying all lawful expenses of maintaining
and operating the schools of the district
provided in the resolution of the Board of
Trustees adopted on February 18th, 2026?"

The estimated average annual cost to the
taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of
\$201.78 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed
value, per year, based on current
conditions. The proposed levy replaces an
existing levy that will expire on June 30,
2026 and that currently costs \$201.78 per
\$100,000 of taxable assessed value.
