Whyte</b></p>	<p>The Board of Trustees of Snake River School District No. 52, Bingham County, Idaho, is seeking authorization to levy a Supplemental Levy for the following purposes and approximate amount of levy funds to be allocated to each use: (i) Teacher and staff support, recruit and retain staff, \$225,000; (ii) Student and staff safety, security systems, and school resource officers, \$170,000; (iii) Curriculum and technology, \$150,000; (iv) Additional staff and insurance coverage, \$55,000; (v) Literacy interventions and all-day kindergarten, \$50,000; (vi) Fine Arts including music, drama, instruments; FFA and athletics, \$50,000; for a total amount of \$700,000.</p>

<p><b>CANDIDATES FOR STATE OFFICES</b></p>	<p><b>NONPARTISAN BALLOT</b></p>	<p>The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$67 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing \$700,000 per year levy that will expire on June 30, 2027 and that currently costs \$67 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year. Therefore, if the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is not expected to change.</p>
