Bingham County Mountain Roads

Citizens have been inquiring daily as to when the mountain roads will be open for travel. Our public works department has been assessing the mountain road conditions daily and our road crews have been working on clearing deep snow from the roads and contending with road washouts. It takes time to clear and repair the roads to make them safe for travel.

BINGHAM COUNTY CODE 7-7-4: D. AUTOMATIC CLOSURE AND REOPENING

2. As of December 1st of each year to April 30th of the succeeding year the County and public roads into and around the Blackfoot Mountain range area, beginning from both the narrows in Wolverine Canyon, Blackfoot River Road at Cedar Creek Road and at Bone Road or any other entrance to the area shall be automatically closed to conventional motor vehicles pursuant to this section and open to snowmobiles or ATVs, UTVs, or motorcycles or conventional motor vehicles all of which are registered as snowmobiles and have been equipped with tracks and designated primarily for travel on snow or ice or to sleds.

On occasion, winter weather dictates the opening of winter roads. We ask people to please be patient in the event the County extends the road closure. If this does occur the extension will be announcing on the county website when roads will be open for safe travel.
